Proposed Budget for April 1, 2021-March 31, 2022

The proposed budget for the current term is on page 2. Please take a moment to review it. We will discuss and vote on it at the May Zoom meeting.

There are still many unknowns for the next 12 months, but we need to plan financially as best we can. The income estimates are very conservative (no new memberships, no 50-50 raffle, no fundraiser,) so we are planning for worst case scenario: we cannot meet in person, or if we can, we are not able to attract new members or hold our usual raffles/fundraisers. The expense estimates, on the other hand, are hopeful, and provide funds to be able to meet again and/ or paid programs via zoom or in person, or some combination thereof. If things open up and we are able to meet again and have nearly normal activities, we want to be sure we've budgeted to allow for it.

This budget projects an ending balance of \$7,762 for 3/31/2022. So this would be with worse-case scenario on income, and best case (hopeful) scenario on expenses. Still a very healthy balance, and in all likelihood, we'll end up with considerably more in the bank at year end. *Polly Oliver*, Treasurer

Survey Results


For those who may be curious, here are the results of the two survey questions asked with your Zoom invitation request:

- 1. Regarding reliable internet service for Zoom meetings, out of 39 responses, one person said they did not have it, another said her service was "iffy," and a third person did not answer either question.
- 2. As for willingness to register for specific meeting times if the Board felt we needed to have two identical live meetings in order to fulfill current state Covid requirements, five persons said they would not be willing to do, two of these explaining that this was because of their doctor's specific orders not to attend live group meetings as yet. Two persons did not answer the question at all.

You can see from the above that the overwhelming majority of responses to both questions was YES.
