FY2019 Fast Facts

A stable home is the foundation on which a family can build a happy, productive life. At Housing Families First, we help make that life possible. Here are a few facts about how we do it.

- The mission of Housing Families First is to provide families experiencing homelessness with the tools to achieve housing stability.
- We carry out this mission through three programs:
 - o Our Hilliard House emergency shelter for families, the largest shelter for families experiencing homelessness in our region;
 - o A permanent housing program called rapid re-housing that helps families quickly move back into permanent homes;
 - o A diversion program and crisis hotline that helps families prevent homelessness altogether.
- Housing Families First uses a Housing First approach to get families quickly out of homelessness. This approach is based on research showing that services to improve a family's well-being are most effective when they are in their own home.
- From July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019, 144 households 404 children and adults in all - received housing help through our shelter and permanent housing programs. 23% of these participants were under the age of 5.
- 64% of families in our programs became homeless in the City of Richmond, 14% in Henrico, 5% in Chesterfield, and the remainder in other localities. Almost One-quarter became homeless in the 23223 zip code, the same zip code where our shelter is located.
- 25% of adults increased their income. That means that an additional \$29,000 flowed into our community.
- 85% of the people in our programs last year moved directly into permanent housing.
- Most importantly, 89% of families housed by our programs in FY18 did not to return to homelessness during the following year.
- Housing Families First is a good steward of the resources entrusted to us. 87 cents on the dollar goes directly to our programs.
- Volunteers, like donors, are a critically important part of our mission. Volunteers give 6,500 hours of time each year. That's equivalent to the hours worked by 3 full-time staff.
